



Turf Type Tall Fescue

Haven't quite been able to dial in your seeding application? Rest assured that SunDial, the newest turf-type tall fescue from Vista Seed Partners, is here! SunDial is a new generation, deep rooted, lower growing, and stress tolerant variety that will make your seeding application shine. Developed and exclusively licensed to Vista Seed Partners, SunDial is a great addition to any blend, mixture, or single variety seeding application.

Adaptation:

SunDial is well adapted to both higher and lower pH soils, and it's summertime performance makes SunDial an excellent choice for areas with hot and humid summers. SunDial forms a very attractive dark green lower growing perennial turf making it especially well adapted throughout the transition zone and into the upper South. SunDial blends great with other improved tall fescue varieties or it can be mixed with 5% - 10% Thermal Blue Texas Hybrid. Broader bladed Kentucky bluegrasses such as Baron or Blitz are excellent mixture components as well.

Traffic Tolerance:



In a traffic study, there was no statistical difference between SunDial and the #1 entry in genetic color, percent brown patch, percent pythium, quality after traffic of 10 games, and percent cover 2 weeks after traffic, percent cover 1 month after traffic, fall color retention after 10 games, fall color retention 2 weeks after traffic, and fall color retention 1 month after traffic. SunDial was equal to the best entries in scientific measurements of both soil moisture and surface softness.

Management:

SunDial won't have you checking the time for maintenance schedules. Maintain adequate water and fertility during establishment and SunDial will do the rest. Once established, SunDial can thrive on lower fertility levels of around 2 - 4 lbs. actual N per 1,000 sq. ft. with applications of P and K depending upon requirements determined by soil testing. Late summer seeding is best when seeding SunDial, but spring seeding will also perform well.
